OK selection and summaries, howlingly awful punctuation and grammarBy Sasha CaveA reasonable selection. Some of the entries are certainly not "must see," while some great movies are omitted. In some cases, the book inexplicably chooses sequels though far inferior to the original. The write ups are generally accurate, though occasionally wildly wrongheaded. For instance, in discussing Animal House, the authors seem not to know the difference between a fraternity and a college. But generally the write ups are useful.The book is badly marred, however, by the wretched grammar and punctuation, which is so pervasive it is a serious, teeth-grinding distraction. Punctuation seems to have been chosen or omitted at random. The authors seem to lack any understanding of the difference among marks such as commas, semicolons and periods. As one obvious and ubiquitous example, they need to learn that two complete sentences are normally separated by a period, semi-colon or dash, not by a comma! The book was either not edited at all for grammar, punctuation and in some cases spelling, or the task was assigned to 13-year-olds. "Audrey Helpurn," indeed!I would have given 3 1/2 stars had there been a semblance of punctuation and grammar.
