It's the kind of coffee table book you might put out on the table over the holidays. A few guests might page through it while one very interested guest could read the entire thing in a half hour or so. There main draws to this book are: 1. It contains a number of portrait shots of the cast members that were no doubt taken to promote the film. I doubt many people have seen these pix over the years. 2. There's a column of buttons down the right side of the book - press them and you'll be treated to Jean Shepherd's voice reciting narrator lines from the film. 3. The book contains a number of nifty souvenirs that are housed in a sleeve bound into the back flap. These include a facsimile of the Western Union telegram announcing the imminent delivery of The Old Man's major award (that telegram discloses the first name of the Old Man for possibly the first time.) 4. The text contains a few observances about the film by Bob Clark and others.
