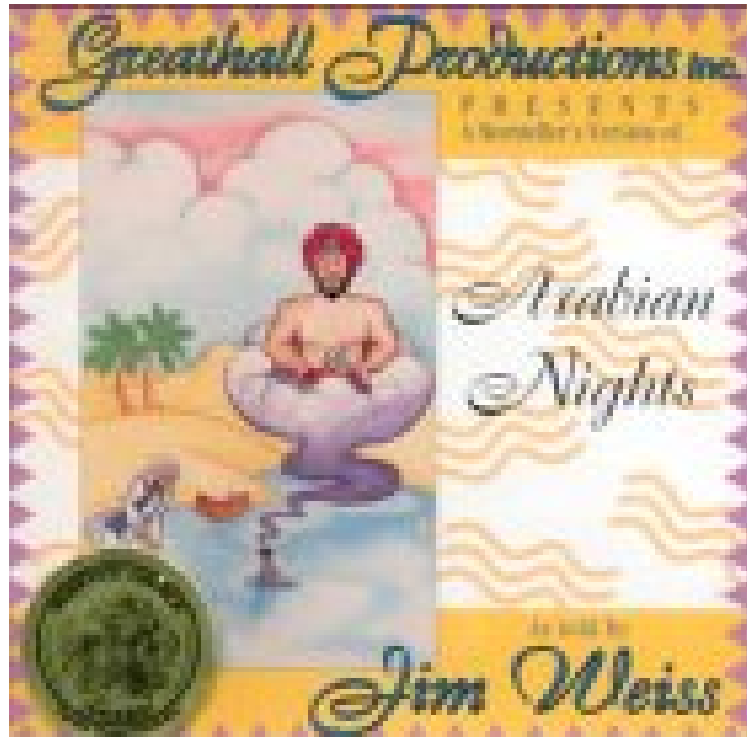

Well done. The problem is that there are only 4 or 5 stories on this disc. Ali Baba and the 40 thieves being the only one everyone would recognize. The others are great stories I just don't know the names. I really really wish they would add book 2, 3, 4 etc. Yes it does recommend going to the library to get the book to read more stories, and we probably will find a kid friendly book version. However we are in the car a lot and want to listen to books as we travel. This CD lasted about an hour I believe. And WE WANT MORE!
