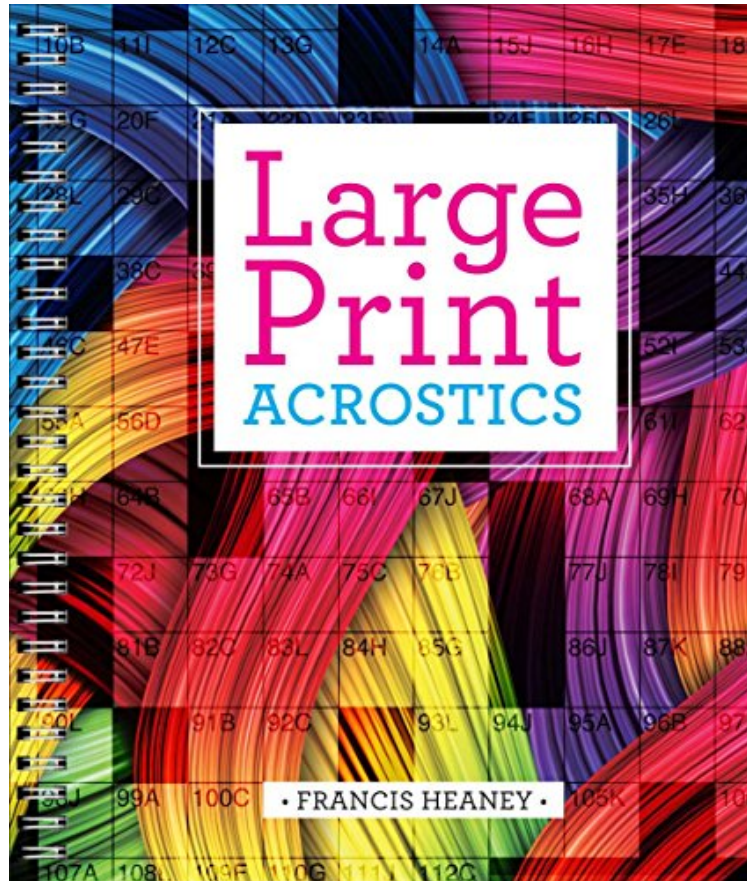

I prefer puzzle books that are spiral-bound so even though it is large print, I was interested. Unfortunately, it is an exact duplicate of Mini Acrostics by the same author. You would not think that a book with a different title and cover style would be the same as another but it is. I have both books and thought that the clues sounded familiar so I compared each puzzle. They are identical, despite the introduction stating, "A regular-size acrostic is too big to blow up to large-print size, so these puzzles are all-new, specially constructed to fit on the page but still easy to read." I feel I have been duped and as a result, bought the same book in two different formats. Not sure

The print is large but the acrostics are shorter and doable in about half the time of a normal-size puzzle!
