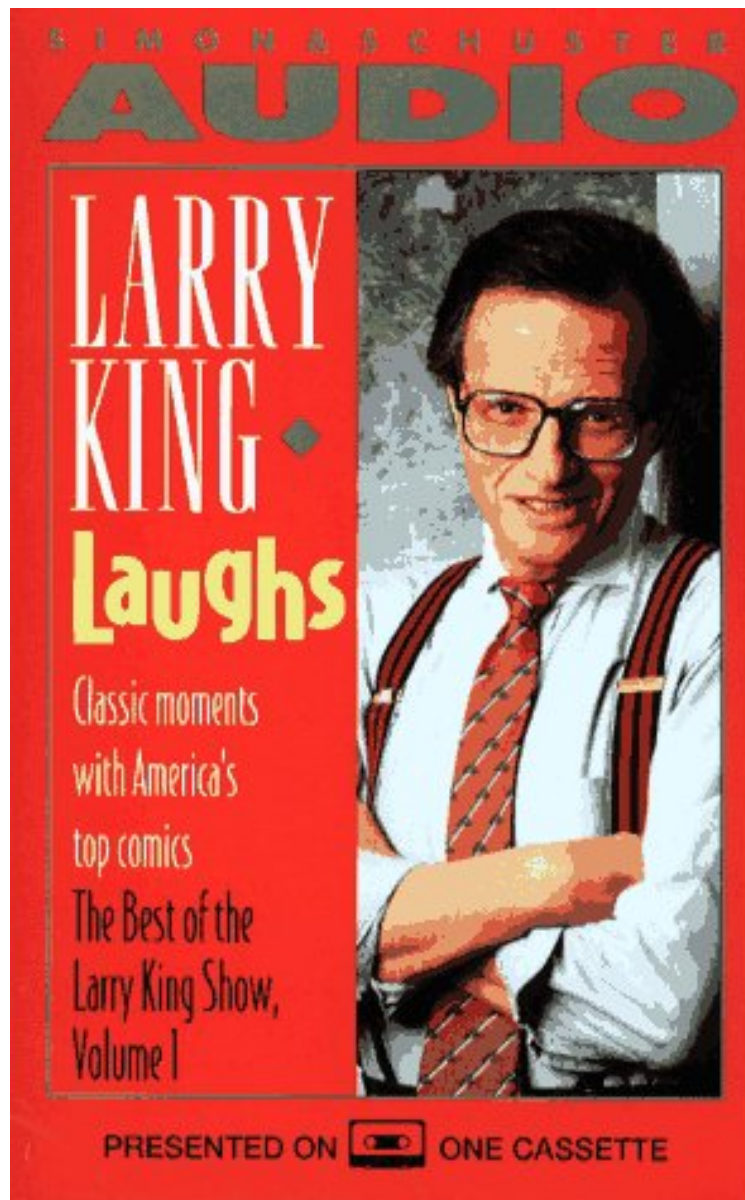

However, the compression of multiple comics onto one tape and the switches from serious, personal talk to comic performance create an unbalanced effect.
