I practiced each song for about a week and 10 days and after that I was finding playing well at some point of time. The main advantage of this book is it has YouTube video which shows how you would play song so you can follow the video instructions looking at those videos and the best advantage of YouTube is you can lower the speed of the video so that sometimes it is difficult to understand how to

play and you can repeat as many times you want. Other than that I don't see James has mentioned in the book what exactly you are learning because you are just playing songs from the way it is written and you are following instructions there is no theory about any material and also it shows a lot of finger technique in the beginning of the course and I don't see how it is going to benefit because you will be focusing on too many things in the beginning of learning piano and I am sure you have to put a good amount of time every day to feel that you learn something it is time consuming and efforts demanding exercises and it will take time to really get the end results and also I would say it is not for those who want to learn in 21 days. This is more of the old way of learning piano.
