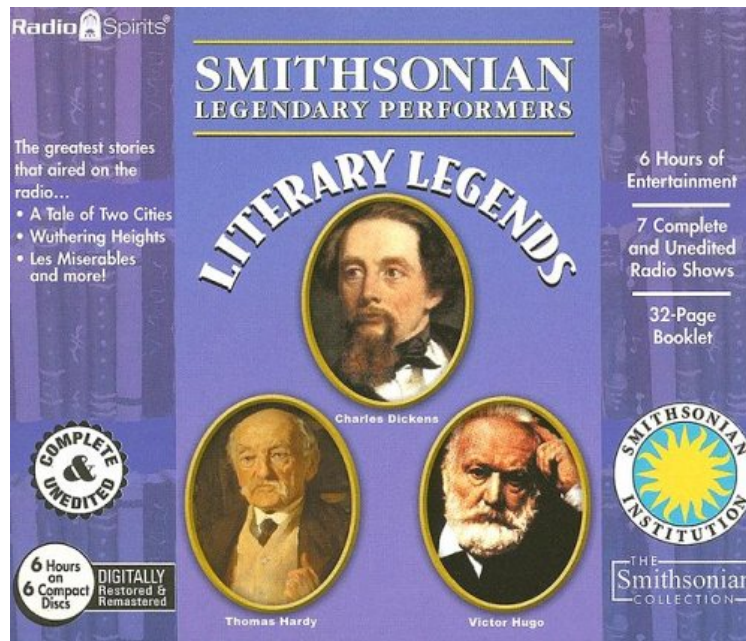

The listener should expect neither faithful renditions nor, despite some famous players, great performances. Rather, this anthology represents the mainstream of 1940s' American broadcasting, with its wonted nonthreatening, accessible, audience-pleasing sound.
