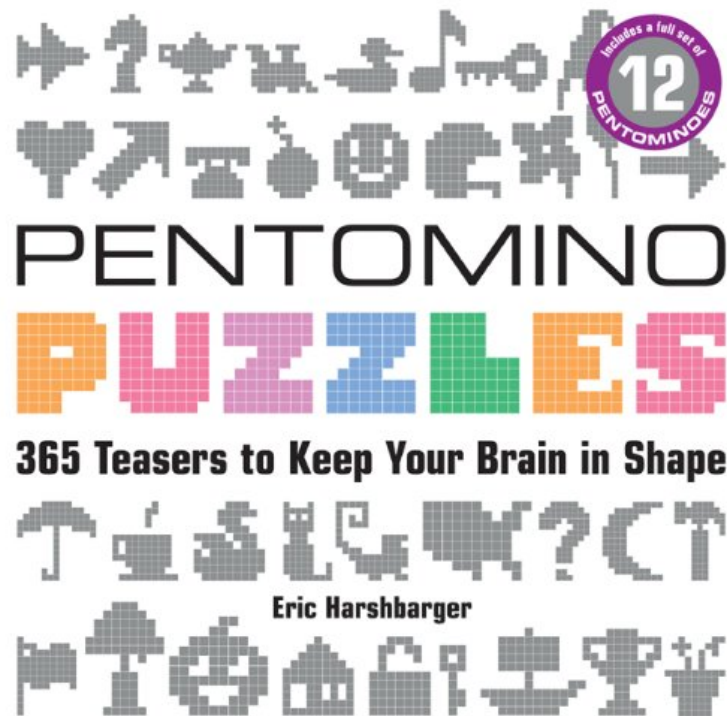

Twelve different colors are quite pretty. The "I" piece measures 16mm x 16 mm x 80 mm, with the other pieces exactly in proportion. There are 96 pages in the book. Only 6 pages are all text. The other pages are nicely printed puzzles (365) first, followed by solutions to all of them. My granddaughter and I will have fun with this book for years.
