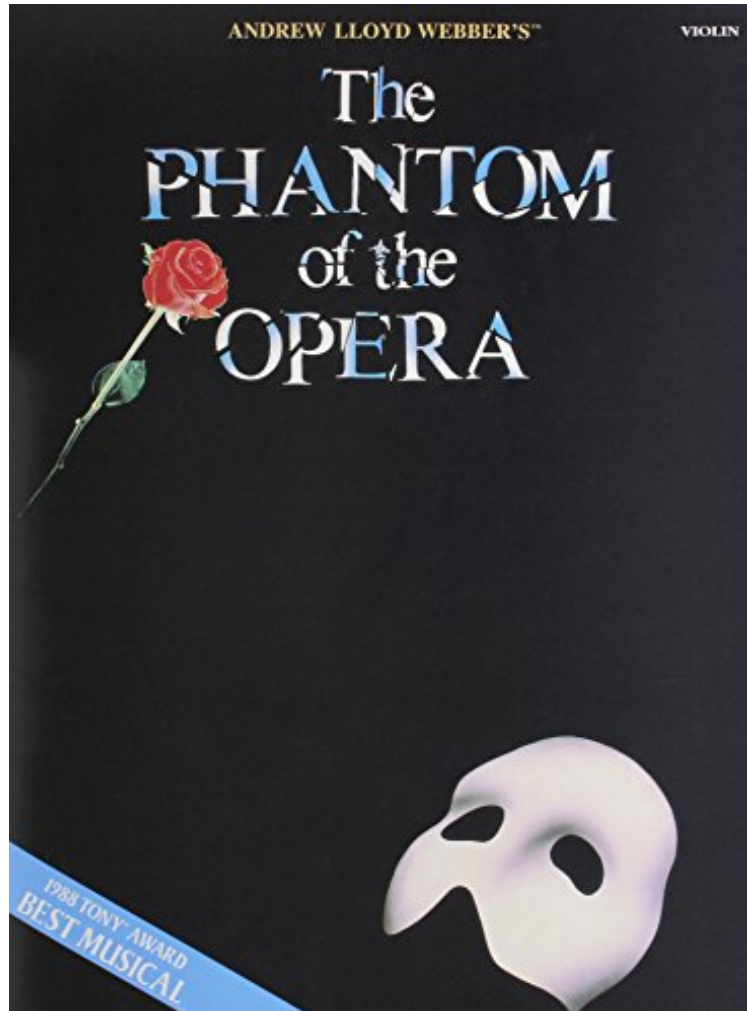

Whoever prepares the books simply takes notes from woodwind sections and slaps it together to call it a violin solo book. Most of the songs simply begin too high and it is then up to the violinist to adjust the piece. 'All I ask of you' is a perfect example. It begins on the A string D (3rd finger), which is not at all how the song is sung or should initially sound. The player has to shift the pitch to either the open string D or 4th finger D (for vibrato purposes) in order to have a nice build from low to high throughout. So all in all, it's a good book in order to get the notes if playing by ear isn't your thing. Just know you will need to make adjustments to play the song as it is sung. I have given three stars because inconveniences like this ought to never

It seems to be lacking in dynamic notations, and I feel they could have done more with the notation itself, adding more slurs where needed. Very plain, but still fun.
